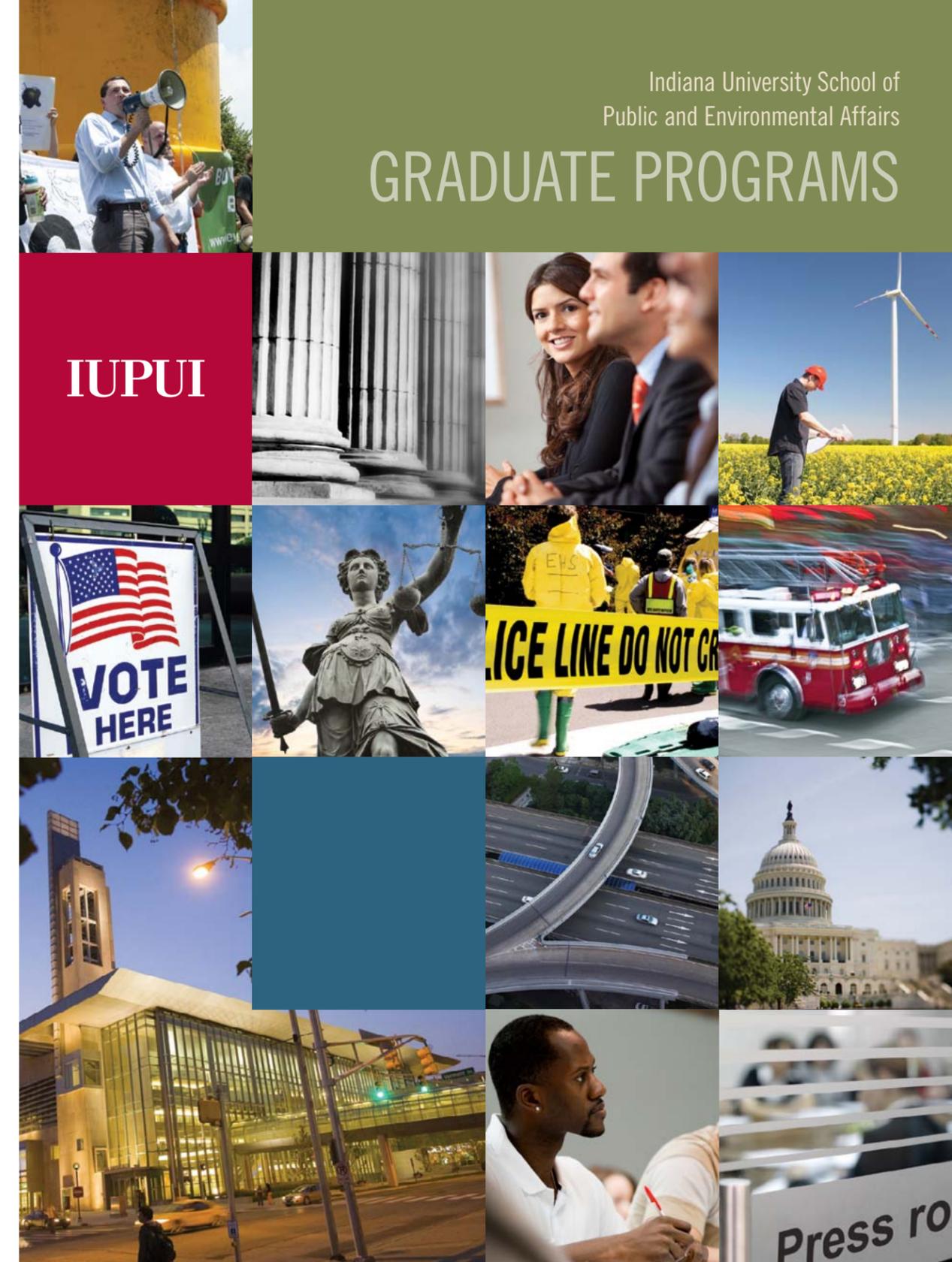

## Degrees to help you meet your goals

SPEA Indianapolis offers many choices for graduate studies:

- Master of Public Affairs, a 48-hour program with five concentrations—Urban Sustainability, Criminal Justice, Nonprofit Management, Policy Analysis and Public Management
- Master of Science in Criminal Justice and Public Safety, a 36-hour program in which you can choose to focus on Criminal Justice or Public Safety. People working in the field may qualify for up to 6 hours of mid-career credit
- Master of Public Affairs – Doctor of Jurisprudence joint degree
- Master of Public Affairs – Master of Arts in Philanthropic Studies joint degree
- Five certificates, in Nonprofit Management; Public Management; Homeland Security and Emergency Management; Social Entrepreneurship; and Executive Certificate in Library Management.

Certificates are a great way to sample SPEA's offerings and launch your graduate studies, because credit earned in a certificate program may be applied to a master's degree.
